Our Bell Tree Stands make the use of bell trees and malleted bells easier! Bell handles are held securely in place by inconspicuous O-rings that can be positioned according to your needs. Stands are 50" tall in their lowest position, but can be extended to 61", 65", 69", or 73" to accommodate the number of arms needed. Base measures 24" across, weighs about 14 lbs., and breaks down into two pieces for easy storage and transport. The adjustable feet provide stability on uneven surfaces and are interchangeable with the locking casters for more mobility. Each stand comes with 2 arms, 4 locking casters, a pack of O-rings, and all assembly hardware. Additional arms and casters are available.

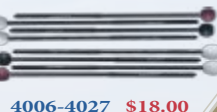
